Many WGNV listeners know that it has been our heart's desire to restore a clear broadcast signal to the Antigo area. A great deal of prayer and effort were directed towards this project in 2000 & 2001 but timing and finances did not mesh and we had to put the project aside.

<u>GREAT NEWS!</u> We've recently filed with the Federal Communications Commission to obtain new translator frequencies in the Antigo and LaCrosse areas! In March the FCC lifted a three-year freeze that prevented us from filing for translators that could expand our listening area. (Translators can rebroadcast our existing signal at a *fraction* of the cost of a full blown station.) We quickly submitted our applications for Antigo and LaCrosse.

These translators will allow our signal to be heard where reception is now weak or not available. If our applications are granted we'll be able to carry the Gospel of Jesus Christ to even *more* listeners 24 hours each day! Please join us in prayer that the FCC will approve our applications so that we might be able to grow and continue our work to the glory of God.

We have before us the challenge of obtaining a new automation system to make better use of the staff that we have and improve on what you hear. Current estimates place the price tag at \$55,000. It's my prayer that you might consider a designated gift for this much needed equipment.

We look forward to opportunities to partner with other ministries to bring the Gospel of Christ to as many people as possible in our listening area. If you've got an idea, drop me a line and we'll start the dialogue. We are still processing the data from our most recent Listener Survey and developing programming that responds to the changing needs of our audience.

2003 also means that we continue to step out in faith. Again. It means living in the Name of Jesus Christ beyond our comfort zone and trying things we've never done before, and challenging others to do the same. How can you be part of this? Invite someone you know to "Try Us and See" before the end of 2003. We're asking you to turn at least 3 or your friends on to 88.5 and invite them to listen for at least a week. Help get the word out about Christian Family Radio! If you need some program guides and literature to share with those friends. we'll be glad to equip you.
